Don't you find it interesting that the major celebrations of Christians, the spiritual significances given to major events in the life of Christ, are part of the celebrations even of those who are not His followers or worshippers? I believe it was in the smartness and shrewdness of God's enemy, Satan, that he simply adapted these to his ways with his additions and embellishment. Instead of Christmas being a world celebration of the birth of its Savior, Jesus, which it means to His followers...so much has been added to it that in many homes and establishments, it is recognizable only as a season of good will and gift giving and happy times as families and friends gather for this purpose only. And then there is Easter...on the calendar and soon to be celebrated. The enemy of the Gospel has added baby chicks and rabbits, baskets, colored eggs, jellybeans, pastel colored banners and new clothes...even an Easter Bonnet parade, once very famous in NYC, and held in other places...all these things the worldling enjoys with happiness and contentment. These holidays celebrated under Satan's influence and direction, are borrowed by him for his contribution of distraction and frenzy of fun. And he happily takes the world along with him.

With Prayer:

So, "Father, what about those of us who belong to You because Jesus was born into this dark world, our holiday we call Christmas...what about those of us who are His because He redeemed His lost world through His death on the Cross, His sacrifice, His days in the grave, His resurrection from death which we call Easter?
